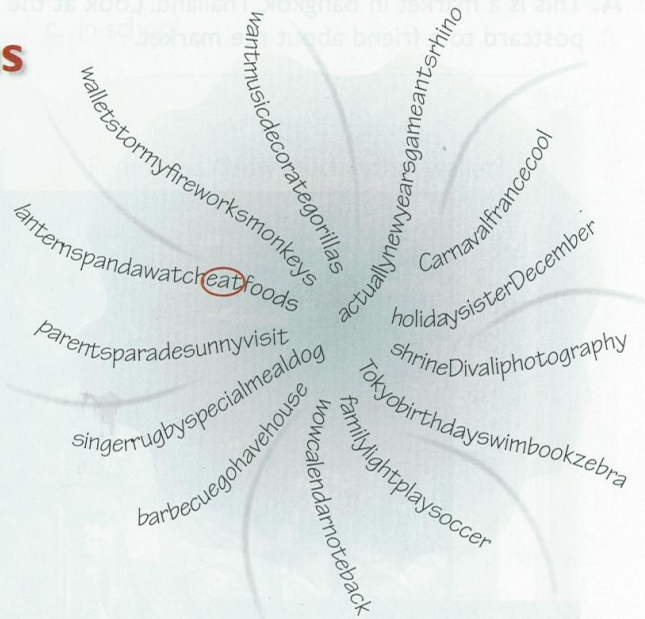

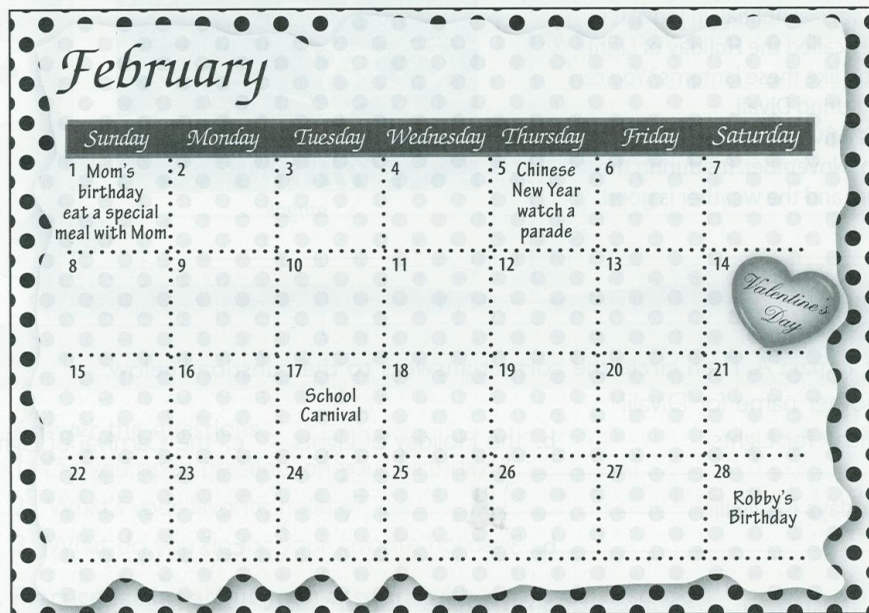

Divali is a special holiday in India. It's sometimes called the Holiday of Lights, too. Do you like these lanterns? You can see them during Divali.

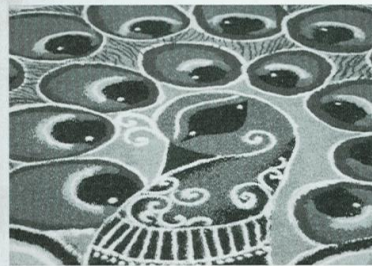
Divali is a five-day holiday during October or November. It's during the dry season, and the weather is good.

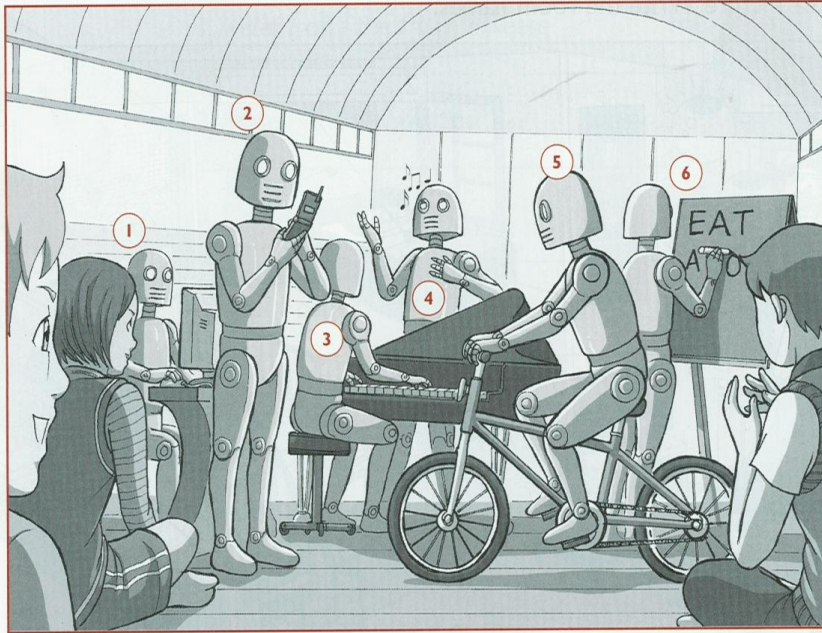
